

Announcement regarding the Open letter of civil society representatives to Boris Tadić, President of the Republic of Serbia, Vojislav Koštunica, Prime Minister, Oliver Dulić, Chairman of the National Assembly, and to all parliamentary parties

Who is interested in slowing down and impeding the European integration of Serbia?
